There are a lot of hotels in Barcelona, and the choice is only limited by your budget and requirements in terms of location and amenities 😊



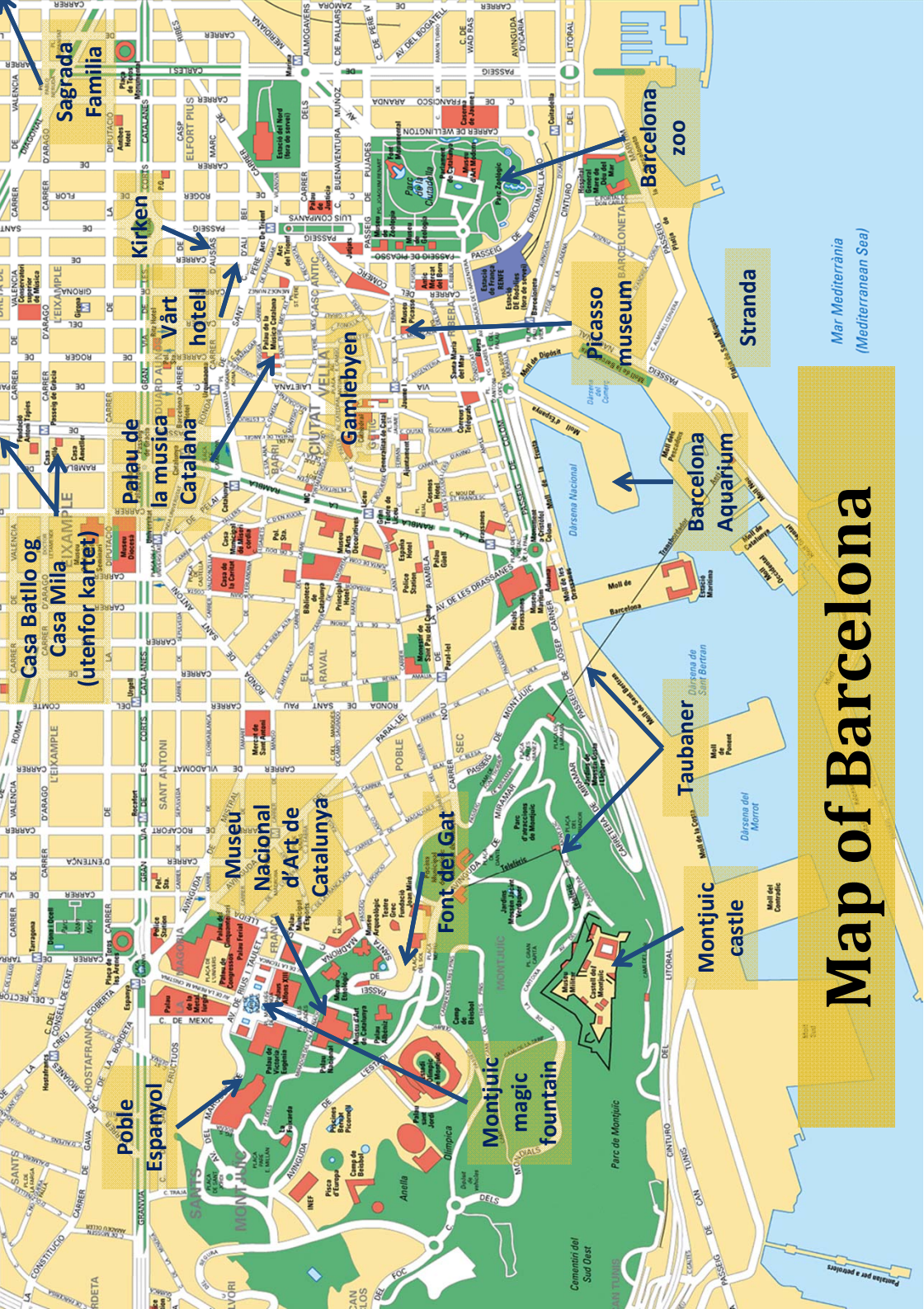


Airport transfer
